A BILL

Places a referendum question on the ballot to direct the UCSU to find legal recourse to the expropriation of \$84,000.00 in fourth quarter interest income for Fiscal Year 1981 from the UCSU by President Weber. In short, that President Weber acted in an immoral and illegal fashion by expropriating said monies, an act contrary to Article VII of the Regentially approved Constitution of the UCSU.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union THAT:

SECTION 1:

The Election Commission is hereby directed to place the following referendum question on the ballot of UCSU Election XV B to be held on 12 and 13 November 1981:

"Should the University of Colorado Student Union (UCSU) seek legal recourse to the President of the University of Colorado's expropriation of the UCSU's interest income monies from the fourth quarter of Fiscal Year 1981, an act in violation of the Constitution of the UCSU, Article VII, as endorsed by the Board of Regents of the University of Colorado."
