### A BILL

# BE IT ENACTED By the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: Seeing that the conference benefits the entire union it shall be funded from Central Reserve not to exceed \$1000.00.

- SECTION 4: This bill will become effective upon passage.
