A BILL

To arrange for voting machines for the Fall 1982 Election.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- SECTION 1: The UCSU Election Commissioner will arrange to borrow twenty to thirty voting machines from the County of Boulder.
- SECTION 2: UCSU will provide transport for these machines to and from campus before and after the election. THE UCSU will enter into a contractual arrangement for printing of punch-hole type ballots not later than July 15, 1982. The UCSU will enter into contractual arrangement for the writing of the necessary computer program no later than August 15, 1982.
- SECTION 3: The Executive Council will contract with the Election Commissioner following the Spring 1982 Elections to make these contractual arrangements.

SECTION 4: This bill shall take effect upon passage.
