A BILL

BILL SUMMARY

Allocates \$250 to advertise two lectures/seminars given by Len Barron.

BILL HISTORY

On Feb. 24, 1983, UCSU Executive Council appropriated a \$300 honorarium to Len Barron to present two discussion/seminars (18ECB-13). These are to be held at 7:30 p.m. April 13 & 27 in G-030. The presentations are entitled: "On the Pleasure of Growing Older and Education" and, I. Do it Beautifully; II. It is 1983 and What are we Doing?" Both are academically sound and thought-provoking. Such events deserve proper advertising to be sure students are aware of them.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: Executive Council shall allocate a maximum of \$250 (\$100 for the first lecture and \$150 for the second lecture) from Executive Council Reserve for advertising expenses incurred for Len Barron's presentations.

SECTION 2: The UCSU PR Director shall be responsible for proper placement/production of the ads and flyers in both the Campus Press and the Colorado Daily.


Sec. 3 — \$80 of the \$250 shall go to the campus press &
SECTION 3: This bill shall be enacted as soon as it is passed. \$70 shall go to the daily x


