## **BILL HISTORY**

The Committee on Personal Safety (C.O.P.S.) was established by Vice Chancellor Kaye Howe, the Ombudsperson Office and UCSU, to promote safety on the Boulder campus. The education sub-committee has developed an extensive survey to determine the extent of the threat to one's personel safety that exists on campus.
