## A BILL

## **BILL SUMMARY**

To establish a Blue-Ribbon Panel to independently assess the differential tuition proposal of the Regents of the University of Colorado.

## BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- SECTION 1: In response to the Board of Regents proposal that a differential tuition be assessed at the University of Colorado, the UCSU will conduct an independent study to accertain the impact of the aforementioned proposal upon students.
- The panel shall consist of members of the Higher Education community (i.e., Administrators, Faculty and Students). The panel shall conduct a differential tuition study and report its findings to UCSU.
- SECTION 3: The panel shall assess the impact of a differential tuition assessment in terms of: financial aid, state funding for higher education, and so forth and so on, keeping in mind that the issue has statewide ramifications.
- SECTION 4: The UCSU shall bear the cost of this undertaking, and shall provide such services as are required periodically.
- SECTION 5: This legislation shall become effective upon passage by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union.
- SECTION 6: This bill will take effect upon passage.
