## **BILL SUMMARY**

Initiates a campaign to lobby the Board of Regents to rescind their amendments to the 1985-86 Student Fee Budget.

## **BILL HISTORY**

At the May, 1985 Board of Regents meeting, the Regents amended the 1985-86 Student Fee Budget to limit the increase in the budget to provide for the UMC renovation bond schedule and the increased cost of the assumption of the Rec Center utility bill. This action will cause a revision and reduction in the total UCSU Budget that was submitted for approval. There is, however, still some room for negotiation with the Board of Regents that could result in some relief for the UCSU budget. This will provide an organized outlet to let the Regents know that the students on the Boulder campus are concerned about the Regents' actions.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- SECTION 1:
- The Executives of the University of Colorado Student Union shall be responsible for orchestrating a letter-writing campaign involving the students of the Boulder campus, expecially those formally connected with UCSU.
- **SECTION 2:**
- Each member of Executive Council, Staff, and Joint Board member shall be responsible for writing a minimum of three letters to the members of the Board of Regents. These letters will voice the concerns of the students about the changes in the budget. They will be given to the President Pro-Tempore, who will be responsible for ensuring that each individual carries out their assigned task, no later than 9 a.m. June 3.
- SECTION 3:
- Each member of Executive Council, Staff, and Joint Board member is encouraged to visit or speak with members of the Board of Regents to voice their concerns about the changes in the budget.
- SECTION 4:
- This bill shall take effect upon passage.
