BILL HISTORY

Vice Chancellor Kaye Howe formed a Drug Policy Committee over a year ago to develop a cohesive drug and alcohol policy for the CU Boulder campus. The final draft of this policy has been distributed and is waiting on action by the Vice Chancellor on what will actually go into effect.

BILL SUMMARY

This Bill shall recommend to the Vice chancellor that: a) the drug policy be resubmitted to staff, faculty and students for final approval; b) the section which addresses punitive actions on behalf of the University in regard to off-campus use and/or sale of drugs be taken out; c) the University allow a student, staff or faculty member to be found guilty by a court of law before punitive action is taken by the University.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union **THAT:**


SECTION 1: The University of Colorado Student Union recommends that:


- a) the drug policy be resubmitted to staff, faculty and students for final approval
- b) the section which addresses punitive actions on behalf of the University in regard to off-campus use and/or sale of drugs be taken out
- c) the University allow a student, staff or faculty member to be found guilty by a court of law before punitive action is taken by the University.


This shall be forwarded to the Vice Chancellor and the Drug Policy Committee.


SECTION 2: This legislation takes effect upon passage.
