BILL HISTORY

At the May Regents meeting the Student Fee Package was passed with a deduction of \$157,466. This represented a student fee of \$130.55 per semester, down from the proposed \$134.20 per semester. After extensive lobbying by UCSU, an amendment offered by Regent Ellins during the June meeting passed, increasing the student fee to \$132.60 per semester for fiscal year '85-'86. This fee still leaves UCSU \$79,266 short of its original budget.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill cuts the original student fee package by \$79,266.00.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union THAT:

SECTION 1: The fiscal year '85-'86 Student Fee Package shall be revised as follows:

1. The Student Fee Allocation to the Recreation Center shall be reduced by \$40,571.

2. The Student Fee Allocation to Wardenburg shall be reduced by \$38,695.

SECTION 2: This legislation takes effect upon passage.
