## A BILL

#### BILL HISTORY

The Program Evaluation Panel (PEP) has planned to review UCSU program areas (specifically Off-Campus Housing, Recreation Center, UMC). PEP is a committee set up by Academic Services to review, analyze, and improve the performance of programs within the purview of Academic Services. As per the dictate of the Board of Regents, PEP is required to review all academic service areas which include UCSU service areas.

Because these areas are primarily under the purview of UCSU and mainly serve students, UCSU wishes to actively participate in the PEP process by establishing a student co-chair and a committee with two additional students from UCSU when the reviews of UCSU areas are to be done. To ensure this, UCSU must pay 50% of the cost of the reviews of Off-campus Housing and the Recreation Center, which amounts to \$3,000.00. (UMC will be reviewed next fiscal year and is not included in this figure.)

## BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates from the Central Reserve, an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00 to fund the program reviews of Off-campus Housing and the Recreation Center.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union THAT:

- SECTION 1: UCSU shall allocate an amount not to exceed \$3,000.00 to go towards the funding of the program reviews of Off-campus Housing and the Recreation Center.
- SECTION 2: This legislation takes effect upon passage.

#### BILL HISTORY
