A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS:The University of Colorado is an institution of higher education; and

WHEREAS:An integral part of a student's learning experience is through the classroom; and

WHEREAS:Part of the learning experience is taking notes; and

WHEREAS:Professional notetaking service is antithetical to the above mentioned ends; and

WHEREAS:Professional notes have not readily been available to students, free of charge in the past; and

WHEREAS:Most other major universities, including Harvard, Duke and Yale, do not allow professional notetaking services;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union THAT:

SECTION 1: UCSU recommends to the Board of Regents on their October 17th meeting when they discuss the above mentioned, that they consider discontinuing the allowance of professional notetaking services on the CU Boulder campus.

SECTION 2: UCSU will notify all professional notetaking services on campus of the recommendation as to allow the above mentioned to respond to the Board of Regents.

SECTION 3: This Resolution takes effect upon passage.
