A RESOLUTION

---

**WHEREAS:** We find the policy of apartheid deplorable; and

**WHEREAS:** Students at the University of Colorado have a responsibility to help end this system because we are members of the world community and our tuition dollars are invested in the South African economy, which supports the Botha regime; and

**WHEREAS:** Being members of a liberal arts institution which promotes certain humanitarian values that apartheid is antithetical to; and

**WHEREAS:** Students have traditionally been the consciousness of society;

---

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** All money collected shall be given to non-governmental groups and organizations and only universities that endorse and publicly support multi-racial universities.

**SECTION 2:** Scholarships shall go to universities that are completely desegregated, and charge the same tuition amount to all students, regardless of race, to ensure that the same education is given to all students.

**SECTION 3:** The scholarships shall go to persons who are currently oppressed by the system in South Africa.

**SECTION 4:** Student representation shall be had in all levels of the decision making process in regards to the scholarship program.


SECTION 5: The University of Colorado shall re-evaluate their current policy of selective investment annually to evaluate the effectiveness of this policy and examine if substantial progress has been made in South Africa to dismantle the system of apartheid. This evaluation process shall also ascertain if U.S. corporations that the University of Colorado is invested in which are doing business in South Africa are positively qualifying under the Regents' policy for investment.


SECTION 6: This endorsement is not intended as an endorsement of the University of Colorado's selective investment program.


SECTION 7: This Resolution takes effect upon passage.
