BILL SUMMARY

This bill shall allocate \$2,548.42 to fund advertising for a Homecoming dance, and a Homecoming Senior Recognition Breakfast.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union THAT:

SECTION 1: UCSU shall allocate an amount not to exceed \$1,940.38

from Central Reserve to go towards promotion, facility rental, security, band rental, decorations, refreshments and other expenses incurred in sponsoring a Homecoming dance.

SECTION 2: UCSU shall be the sole sponsor of this event and its

representatives shall oversee the allocation of funds towards

expenditures related to this event.

SECTION 3: All members of UCSU are encouraged to participate as we will be

the responsible party and host of this event.

SECTION 4: UCSU shall allocate an amount not to exceed \$608.04 to fund

invitation costs for the first annual Senior Recognition Breakfast.

UCSU and SOAR will jointly sponsor this event.

SECTION 5: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
