in any other promotional activities during the dance.

SECTION 5: A written report about the event shall be submitted pursuant to the

provisions of 24 ECB #4. Failure to do so will prohibit future

funding to this group by the UCSU Executive Council.

SECTION 6: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
