BILL HISTORY

In the past, the CEB has had 9 members in accordance with the UCSU Constitution and CEB Bylaws. However, it is felt that an expanded voting membership of 11 would be more representative of diverse opinions.

BILL SUMMARY

CEB shall expand its membership to eleven voting members. (This is an amendment to the UCSU Constitution.)

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: Article VII - Joint Boards and Student Fee Policy of the UCSU Constitution shall be amended to read as follows:

- H. The Cultural Events Board
 - 1. The Cultural Events Board shall include 9 students.
 - a. Two to be chosen by the Executive(s) from the Representative Council – one each semester. The choice must be approved by Executive Council.
 - b. Three to be appointed by the Executive Council.
 - c. Four to be appointed by the Cultural Events Board with Executive Council ratification.

The Cultural Events Board may include two non-students, bringing to eleven the total voting membership of the Board.

- SECTION 2: These two new positions are provisional until their affirmation by the student body in the fall, 1986 UCSU general election.
- SECTION 3: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
