BILL HISTORY

In the past, the CEB has had 9 members in accordance with the UCSU Constitution and CEB Bylaws. However, it is felt that an expanded voting membership of 11 would be more representative of diverse opinions.

---

BILL SUMMARY

CEB shall expand its membership to eleven voting members. (This is an amendment to the UCSU Constitution.)

---

**BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:**

SECTION 1: Article VII - Joint Boards and Student Fee Policy of the UCSU Constitution shall be amended to read as follows:

H. The Cultural Events Board

1. The Cultural Events Board shall include 9 students.
  - a. Two to be chosen by the Executive(s) from the Representative Council - one each semester. The choice must be approved by Executive Council.
  - b. Three to be appointed by the Executive Council.
  - c. Four to be appointed by the Cultural Events Board with Executive Council ratification.


The Cultural Events Board may include two non-students, bringing to eleven the total voting membership of the Board.


SECTION 2: These two new positions are provisional until their affirmation by the student body in the fall, 1986 UCSU general election.

SECTION 3: This Bill takes effect upon passage.


