BILL HISTORY

Traditionally, UCSU has allocated funds to advertise voter registration opportunities to the students, faculty, and staff on our campus. This year, the Boulder County Clerk's office will register students September 15 through October 10, 1986 in the UMC loggia. A Voter Registration Drive will promote an environment for informed, intelligent decision making by allowing students and faculty to meet informally with participating local, state and national candidates in this election year.

BILL SUMMARY




SECTION 2: These advertisements shall publicize the Voter Registration Drive.


SECTION 3: The budget will be decreased by the dollar value, discounted by the Colorado Daily and Campus Press if they so choose to be a co-sponsor of the drive.
