BILL HISTORY

UCSU is an organization set up by the student constitution, with the intent to serve the fee paying students of C.U. In order to better serve the students, it is the responsibility of UCSU to take the initiative to open the lines of communication between the students and their student government. Towards this goal, we feel that the Executive Council must be a leader in this battle to inform the students.

What we are proposing is an original idea to attract the attention of students who would otherwise be indifferent. Council meetings traditionally have been held on Thursday evenings, in the UMC, away from the mainstream of students. So we propose that one time this semester, Friday, September 19, 1986, Council hold its weekly meeting in a most populous area, the UMC Fountain Area, at noon, when all will be abuzz with activity!

As far as details are concerned, KAIR has said they will air the meeting, as well as provide amplified sound, as long as open microphone rules permit, until 1:15pm. The cost of the tables and chairs has been waived, and the only cost for the meeting will be the cost of having Physical Plant turn off the Fountain for the afternoon, which is minimal.

The date is necessary to ensure that the weather will not interfere with our meeting.

This is an excellent opportunity to encourage open and creative government in all of UCSU, and we should not pass it up!!!

This Bill sets the meeting for September 19, 1986, at noon, in the UMC Fountain Area.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

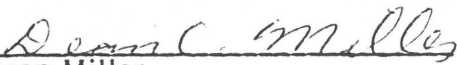
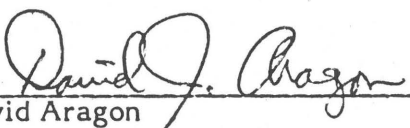
SECTION 1: The Executive Council meeting for September 19, 1986, be held in the UMC Fountain Area.

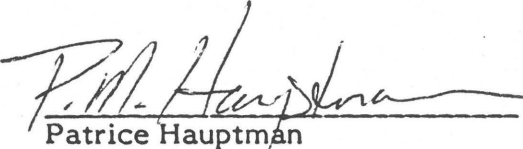

SECTION 2: In case of inclement weather, the meeting shall be held at the regular time and place, and Local Schools Council and Rep. Council meetings will be held at the discretion of the respective Chairs.

SECTION 3: An amount not to exceed \$27.20 be allocated from Central Reserve to fund the cost of turning the UMC Fountain off for the afternoon, so we can hear each other talk after the sound is turned off.

SECTION 4: The meeting shall not violate the rules regarding open microphone in the Fountain Area, which require that amplified sound be turned off by 1:15pm on Thursdays.
