BILL SUMMARY

Student Fee Grant Referendum Question and SFG Task Force Budget.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: The following shall be inserted on the Fall 1986 ballot as a binding referendum:

"Would you be willing to continue having \$5 a semester of our student fee used for the Student Fee Grant (SFG) for the next three years? This money will be used as a need-based grant fund. Up to 25% of the monies collected may be earmarked for target groups to ensure equity of distribution. All monies will be allocated according to SFG Board/Financial Aid guidelines.
