BILL HISTORY

The College Media Journal is holding its annual New Music Convention in New York City on the dates October 30-November 2. This convention will emphasize the important working relationship between college radio stations, record companies, and trade journals.

The convention will provide for the exchange of ideas and skills among those attending. Workshops, symposiums, and lectures will be held to improve the knowledge, skills and understanding of the participants. K.A.I.R.'s Music Director and his assistant would concentrate on learning how to improve an audience base, improve relations with record companies, develop new marketing strategies for the station and its shows, and learn solutions to a variety of problems that often arise at a radio station.

Running a successful music department at a radio station requires its staff to be knowledgeable of changes and trends in the music industry. This convention, in previous years, has provided this knowledge to our representatives. They returned with many ideas that became of benefit to the station.

BILL SUMMARY

This Bill allocates an amount not to exceed \$490 to go towards airfare, convention registration, and expenses for Douglas Feelon (Music Director), and Bruce Brodeen (Assistant Music Director), to participate as K.A.I.R. representatives in the CMJ New Music Convention.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**

- SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$490 to be allocated from Central Reserve to fund two round trip tickets to New York City, convention registration, and food expenses not to exceed \$50.
- SECTION 2: All excess money shall be placed back into Central Reserve.
- SECTION 3: The Chair of the A.I.R. Board shall present to Council, a report of the benefits gained from the convention, in his monthly report.
- SECTION 4: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
