BILL HISTORY

Being as this is an election year, and UCSU is trying to make the students of this campus more politically aware of the issues and of the events of the day; Students Toward A New Direction (STAND), in conjunction with the College Republicans and Campus Democrats, have set up a debate between 2nd Congressional District Candidates David Skaggs and Mike Norton. This debate will take place in the UMC Forum room on October 20, at 7:00pm.

The debate will be moderated, and consist of a panel of journalists who will question the candidates about issues that affect the nation, and Boulder in particular.

What is asked for here is one-half of the partial budget for the advertising, in the Campus Press and Colorado Daily. The candidates themselves will be picking up the cost of flyers, posters, and advertisements in the Camera.

This will be an excellent opportunity for students, faculty and the general community to get an up close look at the candidates and the issues facing everyone in this upcoming election.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill will fund the Candidates Debate \$229.71, to help cover the cost of advertising in the Campus Press and Colorado Daily.

BE IT ENACTED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- Section 1: An amount not to exceed \$229.71 be allocated from Central Reserve to help cover the cost of advertising the 2nd Congressional District Candidates Debate.
- Section 2: These funds will only be used to advertise in the Campus Press and Colorado Daily.
- Section 3: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
