- SECTION 1: The Executive Council allocate \$2,092 (includes GAR of 4.6%) for honorarium for UFW President, Cesar Chavez.
- SECTION 2: This amount will come from Central Reserve.
- SECTION 3: The sponsors will go to Local Schools for additional funding, to be reimbursed to Central Reserve.
- SECTION 4: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
