#### BILL HISTORY

A BILL

On January 29th and 30th, a conference will be held at the University of California, titled "AIDS and the College Campus." Objectives of this conference are provision of currrent information concerning AIDS, discussion of campus response to AIDS including educational strategies and institutional guidelines, and consideration of common problems and barriers to addressing AIDS on college campuses. The conference is specifically designed toward understanding and education about the AIDS problem on college campuses.
