**BILL HISTORY**

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$1,000.00, which includes GAR, be allocated from Central Reserve to Black Student Alliance for the purpose of attending the Big 8 Conference.

SECTION 2: Each attendee is to submit an editorial to the Colorado Daily and Campus Press. In addition, an original idea for education of CU students is to be initiated by the Conference attendees.


SECTION 3: A report on the Conference will be submitted to this Council no later than March 22, 1987.


SECTION 4: This Bill takes effect upon passage.
