BILL HISTORY

The University of Colorado's Mechanical Engineering Department is entering the 1987 Society of Automotive Engineers Mini-Baja Competition to be held April 9-11, 1987 at Cal Polytech, San Luis Obispo. This contest consists of designing, presenting and racing a one-passenger off-road vehicle. Schools from all over the western U.S., including Colorado School of Mines and CSU, will be competing. 1987 will represent the first year of CU's involvement in this annual competition. By successfully competing this year, the ground work will be laid for future CU design teams. Many hours have been spent in preparation to make the rest of the western U.S. realize the academic and competitive excellence of the University of Colorado.

The vehicle is being built, and about two thirds of the travel expenses have been raised. UCSU's help is requested in meeting the additional costs to represent CU at Cal Poly.

BILL SUMMARY

SECTION 2: A written report, complete with team scores and pictures, will be

submitted to Executive Council by April 24, 1987.
