A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: The group, Community in Action, has hindered the efforts of Career Services in its function of job placement in the past; and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Executive Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: UCSU condemns any behavior by any student group seeking to undermine the effort of Career Services in providing career opportunity for the students of the University of Colorado.
