BILL HISTORY

BILL SUMMARY

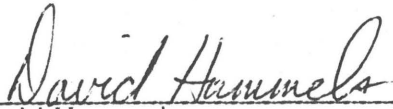
The C.U. recycling program suggests that special efforts be made to recycle materials used during the UCSU Legislative Council meetings.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**

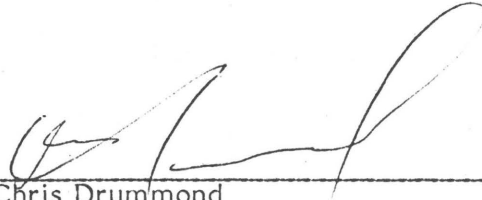
- SECTION 1: Each member of council will be responsible for collecting all recyclable and reusable items & the VPPT shall serve in the oversight.
- SECTION 2: Each recyclable item will be deposited in its proper recycling bin, by the VPPT and reusable items will be brought back to the next meeting ready to use.
- SECTION 3: If for any reason the VPPT can not be present at the close of the meeting he/she shall delegate the responsibility to someone who will be present at the meeting's close.
- SECTION 4: This bill will take effect immediately upon passage.
