BILL HISTORY

The UCSU ENVIRONMENTAL CENTER is a UCSU cost center whose mission is to promote environmental awareness and involvement on campus. The conference, "A Planet In Peril," scheduled for February, 1989, is part of an annual tradition of conferences sponsored by the Center which bring a high degree of acclaim and visibility to UCSU student government. Based on past attendance, this conference should attract a turnout of between 300 and 500 people, about 40% of whom will be students.

Two years ago, an Environmental Center conference about rain forests received the Boulder Daily Camera's award for "Best Environmental Awareness Event of 1987".

The purpose of this year's conference is to give students a chance to hear from leading thinkers -- scientists, policy experts, government leaders -- on the critical topic of global change.

Additionally, the conference, as in past years, will serve to bring new students into leadership positions in student government through the numerous volunteer jobs and opportunities the conference provides. Of all the events the Environmental Center sponsors each year, the annual conference is the most successful recruiting tool.

BILL SUMMARY

The conference will take place Feb. 3, 4, 5, 1989, in the Glenn Miller Ballroom. It will involve panels and workshops on greenhouse effect, ozone depletion, fossil fuel consumption, rising third world expectations, possibilities for international cooperation and other topics. This bill request funding for the "A Planet in Peril Conference.


BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:


