BILL HISTORY





The National Leadership Seminar is the premier training event for AIESEC nationally. It was held in Moodus, Connecticut, August 13-18. The theme this year was "Leadership by Example" in preparation for the new exchange program, "Target". Delegates from Colorado included President Micha Hamady, Finance Director Ed Englby, and Exchange Controller Tony Johnson.

The Conference consisted of training sessions, working groups, problem solving, guest speakers, a mock Target run session and of course meeting people from all over the U.S. and the world. AIESEC is dedicated to internationalism, and developing young leaders, this conference embedded us with those ideas and we left as motivated a crowd of students as I have ever experienced. We are now in the process of turning that motivation into results as AIESEC prepares itself for the Western Mini-Regional hosted by none other than AIESEC-Colorado. We are also implementing training seminars for our marketing, company service, and reception officers for what will be the leading edge in exchange control: Target. This dynamic exchange program will launch AIESEC into the 21st century.

The major other topics addressed include marketing, exchange, finance, history, fundraising, company service, human resources, and leadership. Each day was given a topic and the sessions were led by U.S. National and International committee members. One of the most important functions of this training is to hand down to younger members the knowledge and knowhow of the

more experienced members, it is crucial to the continuity and development of AIESEC.

The guest speakers were business leaders from all over the country. They offered excellent information and were extremely motivating. They included Bernard H. Gustin the Director for Planning for Ernst & Young International who has been responsible for developing a global competitive strategy for the firm's individual country practices. Also present was William Glennon, Senior Vice President and Director of Lee Hecht Harrison, Inc. who provides a range of corporate career services including executive outplacement and national group programs.

As I mentioned earlier AIESEC is dedicated to internationalism. We were fortunate to have have four international delegates join us from Japan, Soviet Union, Great Britain and Canada. Several were there to lead us in international training and several were there to learn how AIESEC functions in the United States, however, all were there to share in the AIESEC experience. We discussed our continuing efforts to support AIESEC-Taipei and the political turmoil in China. We also discussed the newly established local committees in the Soviet Union and Netherland-Antilles.

The National Leadership Seminar meant meeting new friends, learning about AIESEC and the world, becoming motivated, and having a great time doing it. It was giving up sleep for a week to learn all day and party international style all night. Much

was accomplished and much was learned, for this opportunity I would like to thank you, the Executive Council, for your support.

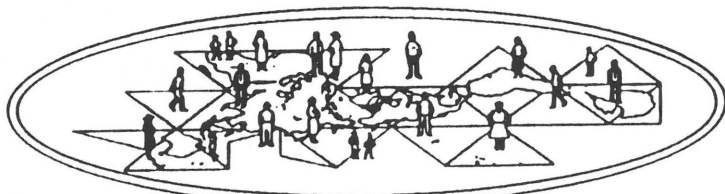
