32 EXECUTIVE BILL #2

BILL HISTORY

On July 20, 1989, a bill was passed by Legislative Council allocating \$3880 to send a mailing to all students (32 LCB #8). The mailing was to inform students of rising costs of higher education.

If one reads the bill history it will be noted that the original estimate for the bill was \$4500. The difference between that amount and the \$3880 actually allocated for the bill was about \$800. This savings was generated by the executive's recommendation that volunteers do much of the mailing & folding labor.

While executives, council, staff and volunteers prepared the letter for mailing, the student finance office loaned us their paper folder. Unfortunately, even though the volunteers saved students \$800 by doing the mailing work themselves, the paper folder malfunctioned and is now broken. The cost of the folder is approximately \$256.35. Because the folder was broken due to a bill passed by this council it is appropriate that council fund the replacement cost.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill shall allocate \$256.35 + GAR from the Legislative Council Central Reserve to replace the paper folder which was used to meet the requirements of 31 LCB #8.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$256.35 + GAR shall be allocated to the student finance office to replace the paper folder.

SECTION 2: This shall take effect upon passage.
