A BILL

BILL HISTORY

The Big Eight conference on Black Student Government was founded in 1977 and formally established in 1978 at the University of Missouri at Columbia. Over the past twelve years the conference has featured workshops on leadership, organizational development, academic survival skills and more. Nationally prominent Black speakers have become the highlight of the annual conference.

The membership of the Big 8 Council is comprised primarily of undergraduate and graduate students at the eight universities that make up the Big 8 Athletic Conference.

Though the Big 8 Council is the principal sponsor and coordinator of the leadership conference, students from colleges and universities around the nation will be represented this year.

The Big 8 Conference on Black Student Government serves as a forum for addressing problems, concerns, and issues of Black students attending the predominantly white universities of the Big 8 Conference.

The primary purpose of this conference is to build leadership and communication skills; promote academic success and political awareness; reinforce the educational and cultural development of Black scholars; promote a better understanding and greater exposure of African and African-American culture at predominantly white institutions like C.U.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill provide funding of \$3,250.00 from Central Reserve for transportation to the Big 8 Conference at Iowa State University, February 22-25, 1990.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT: 32 LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL BILL #10 - Page 2

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$3,250.00 + GAR from Central Reserve shall be allocated to fund transportation to the Big 8 Conference.

SECTION 2: Subsequent to the Event a written report will be presented to the Legislative Council.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
