#### BILL HISTORY

In the time I have been involved with UCSU, I have noticed a willingness by the various branches of UCSU to disregard the basic rights of the students at large. Unfortunately there is little recourse for the offended party other than to accept nefarious legislation passed by UCSU. In order to remedy this deplorable situation the following amendment to the UCSU Constitution is recommended.

### BILL SUMMARY

This bill shall place a constitutional amendment on the Spring 1990 ballot.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union THAT:

SECTION 1:

The following shall be placed on the Spring 1990 ballot:

- A) Add article XVIII to the UCSU Constitution.
- B) Article XVIII shall contain the following subsections.
  - 1. UCSU shall not discriminate on the basis of creed, race, gender, age, sexual orientation, or political orientation.
  - 2. UCSU shall pass no legislation aiding a sectarian organization.
  - 3. UCSU shall pass no legislation abridging the freedom of the press, and/or of free speech.
  - 4. UCSU shall pass no legislation abridging the right of its members to petition UCSU for a redress of grievances.
  - 5. The enumeration of certain rights in the UCSU Constitution shall not be construed to deny or disparage others held by the student body.
  - 6. All powers not delegated to the UCSU government are reserved to the student body.

SECTION 2: This bill takes effect upon passage.
