BILL HISTORY

Twenty years ago, Earth Day occurred in major cities and universities all over the United States. The event signaled the beginning of the environmental movement. This year, on April 22, a similar event will occur. This time, however, Earth Day will be celebrated in cities and universities across the globe. It has been recognized that environmental problems we now face are global in scale and cannot be solved by single nations. For example, the effects of global warming, the ozone depletion, the loss of tropical forests and the consequences of acid rain have world-wide implications. Earth Day will signal a beginning of the environmental decade, during which we must start to solve these environmental problems. The campus event will feature teach-ins, tree planting, speakers, concerts, global games and much more.

One speaker we can bring with your help is John O'Connor, the Director of the National Toxics Campaign. This organization is a coalition of more than 300 organizations including some of the country's largest environmental groups, labor unions, public health associations and citizen organizations. He lends his skills as an organizer and public speaker to citizens working to stop water contamination, clean up toxic substances, and reduce the generation of hazardous waste.

Because a major theme of Earth Day is to broaden the environmental movement, many events will have a multi-cultural aspect. One such event is the Earth Day Blessing, which will be done by a Native American medicine man.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill shall allocate \$3088.50 + GAR from UCSU Central Reserve to fund: John O'Connor for honoraria, airfare, accommodations and food; Earth Week Blessing for honoraria, publicity, accommodations, food and travel expenses; and Publicity for the Earth Week April 16 - April 20.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:


