A BILL

Nuclear testing is certainly <u>not</u> a new phenomenon. Here in the U.S. testing has gone on in Nevada for 40 years, despite stiff resistance by Native Shoshones who were displaced by such testing. Such displacement is by no means restricted to the U.S. The French have been conducting Nuclear tests in the Pacific Rim for longer than the U.S. The Soviet Union's headquarters is Semipalatinsk, Kazakhstan. Both of these testing programs have been protested vehemently by native populations.

French-Polynesian Resistance.
