A BILL

BILL HISTORY

An excellent product of the women's movement, Trisha Flynn, the Sunday column writer of the Rocky Mountain News, will be speaking November 30, 1989 on rape. With the alarming Fort Lauderdale court decision which acquitted a rapist based partly on the fact that the victim was dressed provocatively, it is evident that rape myths pollute our society and justice system. Concerning the alarming number of rapes on this campus, we feel that the demystification of rape through education is necessary. Trisha Flynn is a well renowned speaker on rape and can make an impact on our campus.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates \$1142.51 + GAR from Central Reserve to be used for CWO and U.C.S.U.'s presentation of Trisha Flynn on November 30, 1989 at Ramaley C250 at 6:00 p.m.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$1142.51 + GAR will be allocated from Legislative Council to cover costs for advertising, honorarium, and flyers

SECTION 2: A written report will be submitted pursuant to 24 ECB #4.

SECTION 3: Any additional funding derived from outside sources will be returned to Legislative Council's Central Reserve.

SECTION 4: This bill takes effect upon passage.


