BILL HISTORY

During October and November of 1989 UCSU passed then failed a pro-choice bill; then a Student Assembly passed a similar policy which was then ruled unconstitutional by the Appellate Court. during this time, letters were sent to many public political figures informing them of the passage of a pro-choice policy at the Student Assembly.

During April of 1990, the issue will (hopefully) finally be settled in the student elections. In event that the referenda fails, it seems appropriate to send letters to those same officials explaining the outcome in the election.

BILL SUMMARY

In event of the pro-choice referendum question failing, letters will be sent to the same officials who proviously received letters concerning the Student Assembly, detailing the outcome of the election.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- SECTION 1: In event of the pro choice question failing in the Student Election, letters will be sent to officials who previously received letters concerning the Student Assembly.
- SECTION 2: The letter will be authored by the authors of this bill and signed by themselves, the President Pro-Tem. and the Tri-Execs.

SECTION 3: This bill takes effect upon passage.
