	A RESOLUTION	

USSA proclaims itself to be a national lobbying group concerned with student issues.

Students are concerned with a multitude of different issues as students, from rain forests to choice, but these issues do not often share a consensus among students.

The term "educational issues" does detail more specifically concerns all students share by virtue of being students.

USSA has shown its organizational power when working on educational issues.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**

SECTION 1: The University of Colorado Student Union commends USSA for its current work on educational issues, especially on re-authorization of the National Education Authorization Act.

SECTION 2: We think staying germane to issues of education will improve its credibility with universities across the nation as well as at the nation's capitol.

SECTION 3: Staying focused on educational issues, such as, but not limited to reauthorization of the National Education Authorization Act, financial aid, tuition, quality and availability of higher education will be a strong consideration of the University of Colorado's involvement in USSA in the future.

SECTION 4: To specify our interests in USSA, in the future we will set a yearly agenda of priorities we would like to see addressed by USSA.

SECTION 5: This bill takes effect upon passage.
