BILL HISTORY

During the 31st Legislative Council Session, there was much debate and discussion about what could be done about the Athletic Fee, which was going to increase by 100% for the Fall 1989 semester. Several legislators introduced a bill calling for a student boycott of said fee. That bill was defeated in large part due to the pledge of UCSU Executives Alan Ikeya, Dawn Massop and Tracy Wahl to work around the calendar to fight this largely unwarranted increase, and keep students informed of their progress. These pledges manifested themselves in the form of 31 ER #101, first introduced on July 6, 1989, and passed two weeks later in final form.

Unfortunately, these pledges have been mostly hollow, and today fully half of that bills provisions lie twisting in the wind. This legislation, while not re-instating a call for a boycott of the Athletic Fee, does take this embarrassing piece of Legislation off the books. Given the frivolity with which some bills sail through Legislative Council, maybe this will give everyone cause to be much more careful with the priviledge of introducing legislation.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill repeals all provisions of 31 ER #101, thus voiding it.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

- SECTION 1: 31 Executive Resolution #101 is hereby repealed, declared null and void, and the UCSU Executives are no longer bound by its provisions.
- SECTION 2: This unfortunate, but necessary, legislation takes effect upon passage.
