BILL HISTORY

With the defeat of 31 LCB #28 and the recent actions of the Michigan and Pennsylvanian assemblies it is imperative UCSU take a positive stance in defending the right of female students to choose an abortion. With this in mind I call on the UCSU Legislative Council to convene a student assembly to discuss and promulgate UCSU's position on choice.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill shall call a student assembly as delineated in Article XI of the UCSU Constitution to discuss a Pro-Choice stance for UCSU. Further this bill shall allocate + GAR for advertising the student assembly.

---

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: The President Pro-Tempore of the UCSU Legislative Council shall convene a student assembly no earlier than 2 weeks of passage of this bill and no later than 4 weeks of this bill's passage to discuss a pro-choice stance for UCSU.

SECTION 2: + GAR shall be allocated from Legislative Council Central Reserve to pay for advertising and security at the student assembly.

SECTION 3: This bill shall take effect upon passage.
