BILL HISTORY

There are certain inherent responsibilities that go along with the priviledge of introducing legislation in the Legislative Council. These have largely gone unnoticed in the past. A spelling out of these responsibilities would both help representatives be more aware of their roles, and prevent abuses of this process. When abuses do occur, however, sactions must be leveled at those responsible, whether Representatives-at-Large, CCS members, or UCSU Executives.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill amends the UCSU By-Laws to include both responsibilities and sactions against those who fail to meet these requirements.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1:

A section (d.) be added to Section A-11 of Article III of the UCSU By-laws to read:

d. Responsibilities of Legislation Sponsors are as follows:

i. Sponsors of bills for funding, whether it is for travel or other events, shall be required to see that proper follow-up reports are filed with the President Pro-Tempore.

ii. Reports must also be filed with the President Pro-Tempore concerning ballot issues and changes in any UCSU Guidelines upon passage or failure in the case of referenda.

iii. Any other legislation requiring action on the part of members of the Executive, Legislative or Judicial Braches of UCSU will require that the bill sponsors file follow-up or progress reports with the President Pro-

v. If a bill's sponsors are no longer members of the Executive or Legislative branches, it shall be the responsibility of the President and Vice-President of Legislative Council to execute all provisions of such legislation.

SECTION 2: This legislation takes effect upon passage.
