## BILL HISTORY

Due to the fact that the EPOB Dept. is making all reasonable efforts to both preserve the rights of students and maintain a high quality of education in the CU Biology Dept., and because the overwhelming majority of council concluded the dissection resolution passed by Environmental Board is not in accord with the best interests of a student's education, it is UCSU Legislative Council's duty to overturn this resolution.

When Environmental Board passed this resolution, it became the official stand of UCSU; unfortunately this resolution was not debated at length in Environmental Board and came under strong criticism in Legislative Council. Even though it was Council's intent to negate the effects of this stance, due to a bizarre and twisted set of circumstances, this attempt was foiled.

## BILL SUMMARY

This bill seeks to render the Environmental Board Dissection Resolution null and void.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1:

The Environmental Board Dissection Resolution is

repealed.

This bill takes effect upon passage.
