WHEREAS: The Buffs are the 1989 Big Eight Champion, and;
WHEREAS: The Buffs are currently ranked first nationally in the latest AP poll, and;
WHEREAS: The Buffs have had a record number of players named to the Big Eight squad, and;
WHEREAS: The Buffs have proven their dedication not only on but off the field by participation in community service projects, such as speaking to and working with children at elementary schools.
WHEREAS: Darian Hagan was named Big Eight Offensive Player of the Year and Alfred Williams was named Big Eight Defensive Player of the Year and Coach Bill McCartney was named Big Eight Coach of the Year, and;


