A BILL

BILL SUMMARY

This bill eliminates the UCSU staff positions of Student Affairs Coordinator and Community Relations Director and ratifies the position of UCSU Special Projects Coordinator.

BILL HISTORY

The UCSU Community Affairs Director will not begin work until July 10, 1990. It is necessary, however, to fill this position in the meantime. Because the Director will not be paid until July 10, the salary budgeted for the position has yet to be spent.

Rather than hire a student for one month to fill the position, the executives would like to have an existing staff member fill the position. It is unconstitutional, however, for one person to hold two paid positions within the Student Union. It is necessary, therefore, to legislate the termination of the Community Relations Director as well as the Student Affairs Coordinator for the one-month period, and create a position that will cover the responsibilities of both staff positions. The new position shall pay the sum of the salaries of the old positions, and shall require the sum of the hours of the old positions.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:


- SECTION 1: The position of Student Affairs Coordinator is terminated for the period June 10 to July 10, 1990.
- SECTION 2: The position of Community Relations Director is terminated for the period June 10 to July 10, 1990.
- SECTION 3: The position of Special Projects Coordinator be created and ratified per the following job description:

Title: Special Projects Coordinator
Duties: Fulfill the responsibilities of the
Community Relations Director and the
Student Affairs Coordinator, per the
respective job descriptions.
Hours: 40 - 60 per week
Salary: \$600/month (pro-rated)
Other: Performance evaluation, written reports,
job dismissal, and other position aspects
shall be the same as those for the UCSU
staff.

SECTION 4: The Special Projects Coordinator shall be paid from
the date June 10 to the date July 10.

SECTION 5: This bill takes effect upon passage.
