A RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS:** On May 4, 1970, 4 students were killed at Kent State University and 9 wounded;

**WHEREAS:** Professors Phillip and Elaine Tompkins of the Department of Communication at CU-Bldr, wrote a report on the incident, Communication Crisis at Kent State (1971), as part of a presidential commission to understand what led to the killings;


**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the University of Colorado Student Union **THAT:**

**SECTION 1:** Commemorate in sadness, twenty years later, the deaths of students at Kent State University by candlelight vigil during this final council meeting of Spring 1990, collect monies toward flowers for members of the student union at Kent State,

**SECTION 2:** Renew our committment to standing up for the rights of students, and striving toward effective non-violent communication with the university administration,


**SECTION 3:** This resolution takes effect upon passage.
