- *These scholarships require members of the Financial Aid Committee to sit on the Office of Financial Aid Scholarship Committee in order to be awarded. The administration of these scholarships will be turned over to the Office of Financial Aid.
- B. Set up a Student Fee Grant Board that may include members of the Financial Aid Committee.
- C. Set up a committee to re-establish guidelines for the Scholarship Celebrating All People.
- D. Other miscellaneous activities involving financial aid.
