BILL HISTORY

Each year the custodians at the University of Colorado have faced many problems working under Facilities Management. This year the main problem is the "reorganization" of staff due to "budgetary necessity." The effects of possible reorganization may lead to custodians being assigned additional areas of work without any type of compensation.

BILL SUMMARY


UCSU supports beneficial changes in the conditions of both the custodians and Facilities Management.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, **THAT:**

- SECTION 1:** UCSU condemns the idea of "reorganization" without appropriate compensation.
- SECTION 2:** UCSU demands beneficial changes for both the custodians and Facilities Management.
- SECTION 3:** UCSU supports the idea of the custodians and Facilities Management coming together in a good-faith effort to resolve differences where all opinions and ideas are heard.
- SECTION 4:** UCSU recognizes the United Custodian Coalition and the issues they represent.
- SECTION 5:** UCSU will send at least one representative as an Ad Hoc member to the United Custodian Coalition to help advise and voice concerns.
- SECTION 6:** UCSU demands that as the student population increases, so shall the number of custodians.

SECTION 7: This bill takes effect upon passage.


