BILL HISTORY

The Women's Clinic at Wardenburg Student Health Services was a subject of much debate in the past year. Through the 1990 Spring budget hearings, several problems of the Women's Clinic past were brought to the media and student's attention. The hearings also brought to attention the fact that there is a problem with Wardenburg and CU if Women's Clinic usage is going down while sexually transmitted diseases are on the rise.

The Women's Clinic would like to dispel myths about the clinic and present to students its all female health care provider staff. In order to achieve this on a large scale, the Women's Clinic will be having an Open House from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. in the Women's Clinic at Wardenburg. The Open House will be a time for women students to learn about the clinic, its staff, and current health issues in a casual environment.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill allocates \$150.00 + GAR to fund an Open House at the Women's Clinic in Wardenburg.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

SECTION 1: An amount not to exceed \$150.00 + GAR will be allocated to fund an Open House at the Women's Clinic in Wardenburg to assure large student participation.


SECTION 2: Wardenburg, via Sam Markus, will also be funding refreshments for the open house.
