### BILL HISTORY

On October 17, UCSU and The Rocky Mountain Peace Center, along with the University of Colorado campus groups, will have a day of discussions entitled, "Dialogues on Peace in the Middle East". This will be an educational teach-in for students and the community to explore options for averting war. Little attention has been given to these alternatives in the U.S. media and should be heard. Such topics as the following will be included: racism, disruption of regional indigenous, problem solving structures, the draft, alternative energy policies, the effect of war, non-military conflict resolution, the dangers of a first-strike in a high-tech standoff.

As with our own Civil War, a war in the middle east will surely be a catastrophe for all parties involved, perhaps lasting much longer than originally assumed. Many American families, campuses, social service agencies, cities and the economy will be drastically altered, not to mention middle-eastern governmental and non-governmental groups, families and economies. Lives untold will be sacrificed. Much needed resources will be used. All Americans and the world have a vested interest in considering alternatives to war.

The discussions will be informal with two knowledgeable speakers and a facilitator. Students and the community will be encouraged to share ideas. Topic groups will meet for one hour, from 2 - 10 p.m. in the UMC on campus. A keynote speaker and a debate will occur in the Middle Ballroom. Some of the speakers will be Nobel Peace Prize Nominee, Elise Boulding and professors such as Tom Mayer, Guy Burgess and Fred Demry.
