Bill History

Black Gold is an organization designed to allow minorities to positively express their support for the community, the university and its athletic program. Black Gold was created this Fall in response to the lack of extracurricular activities for minorities especially female. This group promotes awareness of the positive images possessed by minority females, academics and helps erase stereotypical attitudes. It also allows an opportunity to interact with the Boulder community to promote cultural diversity and portray positive minority female role models throughout the campus.

The group consists of 20 members all students - 18 dancers and 2 coordinators. Membership was obtained through auditions that were judged by members of the university ranging from faculty to student athletes. Members are required to maintain their grades, to do community service projects, practice four times a week and attend study table. The group will dance at some football and basketball games and will assist with recruiting and retaining minority students.

As a first year group, assistance is being requested from UCSU's discretionary account. Next year, this group will be applying to be an SOC funded group.

BILL SUMMARY
