## A BILL

## BILL HISTORY

The Student Administrator to the Vice Chancellor of Administration request that CU students (during the Spring Election, April 9 & 10, 1991) are given the opportunity to assess themselves a fee, enabling their CU I.D.'s to be used as a student bus pass. All students will have the choice to vote "yes" or "no"; "yes" vote resulting in \$10.00 student bus pass fee becoming a component on their bill. If the student vote succeeds, students will receive unlimited access to all RTD local and express routes, as well as access to any regional routes for a \$1.00 with the proof of a CU I.D.

BILL SUMMARY

This bill adds a question to the Spring 1991 student ballot.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Council of the University of Colorado Student Union, THAT:

The following question on the Spring 1991 ballot SECTION 1: will read as follows:

> "Would you be willing to assess yourself a \$10.00 fee, per semester, in exchange for unlimited access to RTD local and express routes? Local service would include Boulder City Express service includes routes to Lafayette, Louisville, Longmont, Nederland, and Broomfield. Regional service will be available with a student's CU I.D., plus \$1.00. The student fee can increase as much, but no more than 10% each year without another student vote. This increase must be agreed upon jointly by RTD representatives and CU student leaders."

SECTION 3: This program will go into effect the Fall 1991 Semester if it passes.
